CONGRATUALTIONS AND WELCOME

Baptism is a wonderful blessing that God has given to
His church! It's a means by which He gives us
faith and forgiveness of sins. It's our new birth
into the Family of God! But it's also more than
just a momentary event in the life of a follower
of Jesus. It's a lifelong journey of growing in
that faith and taking next steps with Jesus!

FINDING REST IN CHRIST

God comes to us not with power and force, but with hu-
mility, mercy, and peace. The prophet Zechariah foretells
the Messiah: "See, your king shall come to you; a just sav-
iour is he, meek, and riding on a donkey". Jesus fulfills this
prophecy, inviting all who are weary: "Come to me, all you
who labour and are burdened, and I will give you rest... for I
am gentle and humble of heart". Christ does not promise a
life without crosses, but He promises His presence and the
grace to carry them.

St. Paul reminds us that "if the Spirit of him who raised
Jesus from the dead dwells in you... he... will give life to
your mortal bodies". Through Baptism we are called to live
by the Spirit, not the flesh. As Jesus says, "Whoever re-
mains in me and I in him bears much fruit" (John 15:5). The
Holy Spirit enables us to choose forgiveness over resent-
ment, compassion over indifference, and hope over fear.

Today, many people carry heavy burdens - stress, loneli-
ness, financial struggles, broken relationships, and uncert-
tainty. As disciples of Christ, we are called not only to find
rest in Him but also to bring His peace to others. St. Paul
urges us, "Bear one another's burdens" (Galatians 6:2),
while St. Peter reminds us to "Cast all your anxiety on him,
because he cares for you" (1 Peter 5:7). By living with hu-
mility, trusting in God's providence, and following the Holy
Spirit, we become witnesses that true peace is found not in
worldly success but in a faithful relationship with Jesus
Christ. As He assures us, "My yoke is easy, and my burden
is light", inviting us to share that same peace with everyone
we meet.
